What Trade Means for Maine

Maine companies exported over \$3 billion in goods and services to 165 markets last year.

84% of Maine exporters are smalland medium-sized businesses. International trade supports 1 in 5 (170,300) Maine jobs.

Among international employers, companies from the Netherlands, Canada, and the United Kingdom support the largest number of Maine jobs. Foreign-owned companies are important customers for local goods and services and employ 37,300 Maine workers.




